



NEW MEMBER SCREENING

Applicants for PITTSBURGHSociety of Artists membership are asked to submit three (3) original works completed within the last two years and not under direct instruction. Each applicant is assigned a number which is attached to each piece for the screening. Work is considered by members of the board of directors. Applicants are accepted by a two-thirds vote of board members present. Work must be finished and gallery-ready. Appropriate hangers and stands must be provided for three-dimensional work.

Screening to be held on Sunday, September 17, 2023 Applicants must register for event to be considered for membership.

Drop off three (3) original works (completed within the last two years) to be considered, at the Wilkins School Community Center in Regent Square, Room 105 at 12:30-1:30 PM and return for pickup 2:30-3:30 PM.

Works must be finished as appropriate for gallery hanging. Applicants will be notified of acceptance or rejection via mail. There is no fee for screening. If accepted, annual dues are \$40.00.

Following are rough guidelines board members follow in evaluating submissions. These are based on generally accepted guidelines for judging art.

CONSISTENCY: The most decisive factor in judging a candidate for membership is the artist's ability to speak with a recognizable voice through their work. Consistency in style and medium allows an artist to showcase their talents in the particular area in which they are most accomplished.

VISUAL INTEREST: Visual interest is evaluated by looking at the strength of the work based on the elements and principles of art and design.

CONTENT: The work is examined with an eye towards originality, expression and meaning.

CRAFTSMANSHIP: Craftsmanship is rated according to the skill and degree of quality in the work and presentation.



Pittsburgh Watercolor Society is delighted to present a Weekend Watercolor Landscape Workshop with Christopher Leeper. A frequent award winner in several juried and invitational Plein Air events yearly, his work is seen in solo exhibitions throughout the country. Chris wrote and illustrated Realism in Watermedia (North Light), and has had work featured in The Artist Magazine, Plein Air Magazine, Watercolor Magic, and Ohio Magazine. A 2020 finalist in the Plein Air Magazine Salon, his work was featured in August/September 2021 issue. Chris also serves on the Board of Trustees of the Ohio Plein Air Society, is Past President of the Ohio Watercolor Society, and is a signature member of the National Oil and Acrylic Painters' Society. The first half hour of painting is "make it or break it" time. Learn the importance of value, color temperature, and intensity to spend more time painting and less time mixing.

There will be demonstrations with time for one-onone instruction during the workshop. Participants may bring their own reference photos, and Chris will have reference photos available to paint. He can also provide the demo image to those who want to draw before the workshop. The emphasis is on value, but participants will also learn how a variety of colors can be obtained with a minimum number of paints.

Sue Pollins Design and Display in Water Media Saturday, August 12, Noon to 4PM, Wilkins School Community

A native of Detroit, Susan Laansma Pollins received her BS in Design from the College of Architecture and Design from the University of Michigan. After which she taught art in South Michigan. She is a frequent instructor, juror and demonstrator teaching continuing education programs through out South Western PA.



Pittsburgh Watercolor Society is delighted to present a Saturday afternoon workshop in water media with **Sue Pollins**.

She is a member and past president of the Women's Committee of the Westmoreland Museum of American Art, served as their Education Coordinator and, since 1988, as a docent. Sue is an elected, signature member of the Pennsylvania Water Society and past president and board member of the Pittsburgh Watercolor Society.

Sue's work has been exhibited in over 30 exhibits as a featured artist plus innumerable regional and national juried shows including Pittsburgh Watercolor Society's Aqueous Open, Pennsylvania Watercolor Society's Annual, Three Rivers Arts Festival, Westmoreland Nationals and Southwest Pennsylvania Juried Regionals.



Her pieces are found in private and corporate collections plus the collections of Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art and the Westmoreland Museum of American Art. **WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION**: This workshop will focus on 50 years of teaching design as a basis for better beginnings. Plus, Sue will demo an alternative presentation process that includes any watercolor on rag paper mounted on cradleboard, then waxed with cold wax medium. No need to use glass! With this method, one can get an amazing depth of field much like encaustics. No need to frame, as the board itself is the support needed for the piece. Note, however PWS requires glazing and frames in their shows at this point **Location**:
