



Call for Artists

"Celebrate Steubenville Today" Art Competition

Sponsored by the Steubenville Art Association

THEME: Celebration of the City of Steubenville architecture and the vistas Steubenville has to offer

THEME SCOPE: The subject for any potential artwork to be submitted shall be any current view the artists choses provided it can be identified as being in the City of Steubenville. Views may be of the city from across, above, or along the river, or any other vantage-point of the city the artist can locate. Full views of buildings, structures, sculptures; or details of buildings or structures, is acceptable and eligible.

MEDIUM: All two-dimensional artistic media: Oil, Acrylic, Pastel, Pencil, Colored-pencil, Charcoal, or Ink Drawing, Water Media, Mixed Media (includes collage), Cold Wax, Encaustic. Sculptures of any traditional material (clay, wood, metal, etc.) are also eligible. NO live vegetation. No jewelry, as we cannot secure it. Printmaking processes resulting in what would be considered original works of art (relief {linocut, woodcut, monoprints), intaglio (etching, engraving), serigraphy (stencil) or planographic (stone lithography}) are permitted. No photographic prints or retouching, photo-transfers, digital-imaging, videos, or installations. Sculpture should be free-standing or your own pedestal should be provided, unless able to be placed on a regulartabletop. **No loose-pieces for three-dimensional** artwork...all pieces should be adhered and **secured**. Hanging relief/three-dimensional work that does not protrude more than sixinches from the wall and that does not exceed the weight-limit of 25 lbs., is also permitted. We reserve the right to refuse any two-dimensional work that will not securely hang on our system, or any three-dimensional work that cannot be appropriately displayed.

OPENING RECEPTION/AWARDS PRESENTATION:

A reception and awards presentation open to the public will held Saturday March 4, 2023 1:00 PM-3:00 PM in the Historic Fort Steuben Visitors Center

ENTRIES/AGREEMENT AND PERMISSION:

Living artists, 18 years of age or older may enter up to three-pieces for \$30 for SAA non-members and \$25 for SAA members. Submission of work guarantees an agreement to all the conditions in this prospectus, including permission for reproduction in print and electronic media and news-releases for purposes of SAA publicity.

CREATION REQUIREMENTS: ORIGINAL ARTWORK ONLY.

All artists are encouraged to create their work using their own compositional design or reference photographs. Work may also be created en plein-air (on location). The intent of this themed competition is to capture Steubenville as it presently exists. Utilizing historical photographs depicting Steubenville's past will not be accepted. No online-stock photographs of Steubenville nor work created from another artist's design. Should an artist choose to use a photo by another individual, the artist is responsible for acquiring permission from the photographer and producing a written and signed release from the photographer when delivering their entry.

All artwork must have been created between October 1, 2019 and March 2, 2023 and must not have been displayed in any other SAA show(s) including the Ft. Steuben show last March 2022 and the scheduled Summit Art Gallery Show in July 2022.

DISPLAYING REQUIREMENTS: All artwork shall have eye-hooks or D-Rings, and wire and ready to hang. NO SAWTOOTH hangers. Gallery-wrap is permitted for panel or canvas. Watermedia

must also be matted and under glass or plexiglass. Pastels should be under glass, with or without matting. Size limits 42" in any direction and not exceeding 25 pounds. The subject view of the city must be identified on the bottom or back of the entry form.

PRIZES: OVER \$900 in Award monies will be distributed. Mr. Fritz Hartman (not affiliated with the SAA) will be the juror to select the following winners:

Best of Show \$ 275 Second Place \$150 Third Place \$100 Fourth Place \$75 Four (4) Honorable-mention at \$50 each.

There will also be special awards given which will later be announced. Mayor's Award, People's Choice, etc.

COMMISSION: Art sold will be assessed a twenty-per-cent (25%) commission fee with 10% retained by the Historic Fort Steuben and 15% retained by the SAA.

INSURANCE: Insurance on all works of art is the responsibility of the artist.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Please contact Gina Judy at 740-765-4410 for an application. Fill out the entry form, and be sure to list the name and location of your building and/or vista, and surrogate reference creator if required, and please attach any photo releases. Bring with your artworks to the Historic Fort Steuben Visitors Center Wednesday, March 1, 2023 and Thursday, March 2, 2023 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. Cash or checks will be accepted. Please make checks payable to Steubenville Art Association.

Pickup will be at the show location on Thursday, March 30 and Friday, March 31 from 10:00 AMuntil 4:00 PM.

NEW MEMBER SCREENING

This is your year to become a member of the PITTSBURGH Society of Artists, one of the largest artist guilds in western Pennsylvania with more than 300 artist members in all media. We offer artists the chance to join with peers in a lifelong pursuit of artistic expression.

Since 1965, the PITTSBURGH Society of Artists remains dedicated to providing our members with exhibition opportunities and encouraging creative thinking through meetings, workshops, critiques, field trips to museums, artist studios and much more. Become a PITTSBURGH Society of Artists member and take advantage of our valuable resources for personal and artisitic growth such as the fellowship of your peers and interesting programs.

As a member of the PITTSBURGH Society of Artists, all this can be yours. There is no fee for screening. If accepted, annual dues are \$40.00.

Applicants for PITTSBURGHSociety of Artists membership are asked to submit three original works completed within the last two years and not under direct instruction. Each applicant is assigned a number which is attached to each piece for the screening. Work is considered by members of the board of directors. Applicants are accepted by a two-thirds vote of board members present. Work must be finished and gallery-ready. Appropriate hangers and stands must be provided for three-dimensional work.

Following are rough guidelines board members follow in evaluating submissions. These are based on generally accepted guidelines for judging art.

CONSISTENCY: The most decisive factor in judging a candidate for membership is the artist's ability to speak with a recognizable voice through their work. Consistency in style and medium allows an artist to showcase their talents in the particular area in which they are most accomplished.

VISUAL INTEREST: Visual interest is evaluated by looking at the strength of the work based on the elements and principles of art and design.

CONTENT: The work is examined with an eye towards originality, expression and meaning.

CRAFTSMANSHIP: Craftsmanship is rated according to the skill and degree of quality in the work and presentation.

All due care will be taken handling art during screening hours. PSA is not responsible for loss or damage of art works.


TRIVIL ART FAGT

Helen Frankenthaler 1928-2011 (aka Mrs. Robert Motherwell)

Frankenthaler's method of paint application was markedly original: she thinned the oil paint to the consistency of watercolor so that it would soak into and stain the canvas rather than accumulate on its surface. She applied the paint using a coffee can with a hole cut in it, which allowed her to create puddles that could be left as is or spread on the surface.




The Exhibition Space: The Cranberry Township Municipal building, located at 2525 Rochester Road, Cranberry Township, PA 16066.
