This Month's Guest Demonstration:

PYSANKY - "EGG WRITING"

Presented by Diane Pontoriero



Ukrainian Easter Eggs are a folk art of the eastern regions of Europe, dating back centuries. Pysanky is a batik process, using beeswax to draw designs and patterns on the eggs and acid dyes to create the color. The egg was used as it was a symbol of rebirth and the bringing forth of spring. The intricate patterns, symbols, and colors on the eggs are signs of good luck, spring, good harvest, health, Easter, Lent, Christianity, etc.

Diane Pontoriero will have a variety of Pysanky to show and discuss their unique meanings. She will talk about the symbolism and colors, how the meanings changed over time, and

will demonstrate the batik process of Pysanky, using the "Kistka", the writing tool, from start to finish.

Diane Pontoriero is an artist/art educator with a bachelor degree in Landscape Architecture and Masters degree of Art Education. She has taught elementary/middle school art in the North Hills and is an instructor and the pottery supervisor at the North Hills Art Center. Diane enjoys teaching pottery, drawing, pastel, watercolor, Shibori, Pysanky, fused glass and more at the art center. She is the current President of the Board of Directors at the North Hills Art Center.





dedicated to providing our members with exhibition opportunities and encouraging creative thinking through meetings, workshops, critiques, field trips to museums, artist studios and much more. Become a Pittsburgh Society of Artists member and take advantage of our valuable resources for personal and artistic growth such as the fellowship of your peers and interesting programs. As a member of the Pittsburgh Society of Artists, all this can be yours. There is no fee for screening. If accepted, annual dues are \$40.00.

Applicants for Pittsburgh Society of Artists membership are asked to submit three original works completed within the last two years and not under direct instruction. Each applicant is assigned a number which is attached to each piece for the screening. Work is considered by members of the board of directors. Applicants are accepted by a two-thirds vote of board members present. Work must be finished and gallery-ready. Appropriate hangers and stands must be provided for three-dimensional work.





Call for Artists at Ketchup City Creative! All artists are welcome to submit 2D works featured on non-traditional shaped panels and canvases. No Rectangle or Square shaped works allowed!

There is no size limit to this call. However, smaller works are preferred. Artists can submit 2 pieces. There will be a \$15 hanging fee per work accepted. These fees are nonrefundable and help pay for the studio space and show production. Work must be ready to hang with a wire or sawtooth hook. Every year, the Westmoreland Arts & Heritage Festival holds the Westmoreland Art Nationals, a juried fine art and photography competition, featuring art from all around the country. Artists are permitted to enter as many pieces as they'd like to be considered in both of our exhibits.

The first exhibit will be held in Commissioners Hall at Westmoreland County Community College. The exhibit will run from Sat., May 21 through Wed., June 8, with the Opening Reception on May 21 from 6-8 PM. Awards will be Announced at 7PM on May 21 and posted on our Facebook page.

The second exhibit will be held at the Westmoreland Arts & Heritage Festival on Thursday, June 30 through Sunday, July 3 with the Opening Reception set for Saturday, June 25 from 6-8 PM. Awards will be Announced at 7:00 PM on June 25 and posted on our Facebook page. Both shows are free and open to the public to attend.

Digital exhibitions will have artwork that is accepted into both exhibits and will also be displayed on our Facebook page and

website. The first Exhibit will run from May 21 – June 18, 2022 and the second Exhibit will run from June 25 – July 23, 2022.

The People's Choice Award will be decided by the number of votes received on-site through paper ballots as well as votes taken from our Facebook Page using the number of "Likes" on an image. Any accepted piece of artwork may be voted on to win the People's Choice Award. Voters are permitted to cast one ballot per artist per day.

A total of \$4,800 in prize money will be awarded in the following categories:

Best of Show Photography
Painting Mixed Media

Graphics Digital Media/Digital Art

Craft New Entrant Sculpture People's Choice

Winners are selected for each exhibit and are not announced until the night of the Opening Receptions. Both shows provide excellent exposure and serve as wonderful networking opportunities to meet other distinguished artists.
