

Fire Arts: anything requiring heat - clay, encaustic, metal, glass, etc.

Size limits: 2-D guilt and wall art: 4' x 4'; 3-D: 4' x 3' x 3'

Drop off 5/24-5/28, 10am-3pm & 5/25, 7-9pm

Pick up 7/6-7/9, 10am-3pm & 7/6, 7-9pm

The artist may enter up to three pieces: **members-\$10*** per piece, **nonmembers-\$15*** per piece. Only recent work that has not been in a previous show at the NHAC may be submitted. Artists will be notified at drop off of any unaccepted entries. **Each piece must be ready for display or hanging.** Work with gallery clips or saw tooth clips will not be accepted. No piece of artwork shall be substituted or removed until the last day of the show.






