This Month's Guest Artist: Victor Beltran



After many years of sketching throughout the world, Victor has developed extraordinary fine-tuned skills where he can quickly sketch spontaneously to produce stunning images regardless of place or setting.

Beltran produces artistic works that build on his talents and training which is expressed in his spontaneous art forms. In the spring of 2009, Victor produced an event, Art Just in Time, where he produced 16 acrylic paintings in a day. Recently, during a live performance by the Bach Choir of Pittsburgh, Victor created 4 paintings while perched on high a scaffold during Musssorgsky's Pictures at an Exhibi-

tion. During his travels to Europe, Canada, Ecuador, Mexico and Eastern United States, Victor Beltran has completed over 60 sketch books which depict thousands of locals including the Swiss Alps, Venice, Paris, Amsterdam, Munich, Rome, Sienna, Florence, Seville, Cordoba, Granada and San Miguel de Allende, Taxco, Morelia and Quito.

Victor Beltran is a member of the Pittsburgh Watercolor Society and Associated Artists of Pittsburgh. Beltran, a native of Lima, Peru, came to Pittsburgh in 1986 and currently resides in the Fox Chapel Area.




WHAL April Challenge: Use a color palette from nature

Call for Artists



We welcome your participation in the Monaca Community Development Corporation's ArtWalk 2023 which will include an art exhibition hosted in various storefronts in our downtown business district and a kickoff event at the Riverfront Park. The kickoff event entitled Brushes, Blooms and Brew, will be on May 27, 2023 from 1pm to 6pm and ArtWalk 2023 will begin on May 27th and continue through to zJune 17th. Those exhibiting at the kickoff will have a 10' space to set up, exhibit and sell their works. Each artist is responsible for supplying their own tables, tents and any necessary supplies for displaying their work. The fee for participating in the kickoff, Brushes, Blooms and Brew, includes the exhibition cost of two pieces of art work in ArtWalk 2023. For those not taking part in the kickoff there is a per piece fee for participation in ArtWalk 2023.

All those participating in ArtWalk 2023 will be given the name and contact information of a participating business in order to make arrangements for setting up the store display of one to three pieces of work in the days prior to the shows start date. For an additional \$10 a third piece of work may be submitted.

Guidelines:

All artwork must be ready for display, including table top easels for works that are 16" x 20" or less, and floor easels for pieces 16" x 20" or larger. Work should be framed and ready for display at the time of exhibition. There are a limited number of easels available through the MCDC on a first-come, first served basis. Please make arrangements with the CDC if you wish to use one of these easels.

Each artist may display no more than three (3) pieces of art in the storefront walk-by exhibition. The curating fee for the exhibition will be \$10.00 per piece of art. Those participating in the Brushes, Blooms and Brew event will pay a \$25.00 fee for the event that includes the exhibition price of two pieces in ArtWalk 2023 and may choose to exhibit a 3rd piece of work for a \$10.00 fee. All fees may be paid by check, cash or money order. Checks and money orders should be made payable to Monaca CDC and with registration form mailed to: Monaca CDC, 998 Indiana Avenue, Monaca PA 15061 no later than May 13,2023. All entry fees will be received by the CDC and will be expended back into the community for future CDC projects, including but not limited to Arts in Monaca.

On Saturday a afternoon, May27, 2023 from 1pm to 6pm there will be a kickoff event,Brushes, Blooms and Brew, for ArtWalk 2023. The festival will \be held at the Riverfront Park.Artists who are participating in this event will be responsible for setting up their own displays and handling their own sales at the event. Set-up at the park will begin at 10am.

Event Promotion:

This event will be heavily promoted on social media, websites, newsletters and newspaper media. Photographs of artwork may be utilized to promote the opening festival and the three week long art walk.



- Entrance fee for up to 2 pieces of art is \$20 for members of CAN and \$25 for non-members.
- For all entries, please send your entrance fee via PayPal through our website www.cranberryartistsnetwork.com/2023monet no later than Sunday, June 25 at 8:59 p.m.
- · No registration payments will be accepted during the drop off.

Entry Regulations:

- Artists are permitted to submit 1-2 pieces of art for entry in any medium (except film or video and installations).
- Artists must be located within a 150-mile radius of Cranberry Township.
- Artwork must have been produced within the last 3 years and not have previously been shown in Cranberry Township.
- · Original Artwork only (no reproductions).
- 2-D works must be professionally presented and ready to hang.
 No sawtooth hangers, picture wire and mounting hardware securely attached to frame only, not the backing. Pieces with unsecure wiring will be rejected at drop-off.
- · 3-D works must be exhibit ready.
- Size limitations 36" W x 50" H including frame. Please note: these dimensions are absolute, artwork & frame wider than 36" will be rejected.
- Please note: These dimensions must include the frame for paintings. The depth dimensions will also apply for sculptures, ceramics, pottery and tapestries. Any artwork that does not comply will be rejected.

- All work must have 2 registration tags attached to the back of the work upon delivery. (See page 2 of the prospectus for registration tags.)
- · Digital registration only.
- All entries must be accompanied by a clear, focused picture of the submitted artwork.
- Entry pictures must be in JPEG format with at least 72dpi and should not exceed 5MB.

Notification of Acceptance

 Notification of acceptance will be sent via email on or about Sunday, July 2, 2023

Drop Off:

- Accepted artwork must be dropped off to be hung on Thursday, July 6, 2023 between 4 and 7pm at the Municipal Center.
- · Artwork must hang for the duration of the show.

Pick Up:

 Artwork must be picked up on Thursday, August 24, 2023 between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Municipal Center. Artwork not picked up within the scheduled return date will be placed in storage at the artist's risk and expense. A \$25 storage fee will be assessed.
 Artworks remaining after 30 days become the property of CAN.
