Lisa Markowski is a contemporary mosaic artist. Her process for designing fine art, mirrors and jewelry is evolutionary, driven by colors of glass and textures of diverse materials. She often starts with a specific piece of glass and then selects her subject and gathers potential materials – stained glass, tiles, millefiori, smalti, beads, stone, metal and pottery.

As she focuses on the interplay between color and texture, the work inevitably morphs many times. The original idea becomes more developed, the colors and shapes inspire her to go in different directions. The finished pieces are individual creations that she hopes bring joy.







Fall is here and winter is right around the corner and with this change comes a variety of foggy icy mornings and grey misty days. This month's challenge is to create an atmospheric perspective artwork.

Achieve atmospheric perspective by using less intense, more neutral color as you move back through the painting. The colors of things in the distance are usually cooler in temperature and lighter in value. One way to do this is to mix the sky color into the color of the far objects.

Selections will be made that day and the show will be hung the same day. If any artwork cannot be included into the artisty will be notified and the artwork must be picked up by 1pm.

No entry fee and PAACC will not be taking commission. All sales will be directed toward the artist.

2D Artists may submit up to 4 pieces.

3D sculptural artists may submit up to 4 pieces 12"x12" or less in size for display case.

All artwork must be delivered ready to hang and include any accessories, electronics and appropriately attached hanging wires. Sawtooth hangers will not be accepted because it is not compatible with the hanging system.

This is for the security of the artwork and safety of the PAACC staff and guests.

QUALITY FRAMING OR MOUNTING REQUIRED FOR ALL ARTWORKS SUBMITTED! UNDER 36" IN ANY DIRECTION MUST BE FRAMED, UNLESS 2' GALLERY WRAPPED! ARTWORK ABOVE 36" IN ANY DIRECTION CAN BE SUBMITTED UNFRAMED WITH CLEAN PAINTED SIDES. Artwork must stay up until the next change out! No exceptions!
