Stained Glass Artist, Designer & Manager: Williams Stained Glass Studio

Keeley began her stained glass career in 2006 as an apprentice at Williams Stained Glass Studio in the Castle Shannon area of Pittsburgh. In 2015, she took over the head design & managing duties, and also makes or repairs panels and lampshades for the studio.

On her own time, she is working on a colorful series of rock icons/bands, with the hopes of having an exhibition in the near future.

In addition to stained glass, she does commissioned charcoal drawings (mainly portraits); watercolor, oil & acrylic paintings; and attends weekly pottery workshops at the North Hills Art Center.

Keeley graduated from the Ohio State University in 2002, with a Bachelor's degree in Art Education. She was also a member of the OSU women's track team, competing in the Javelin event for 4 years. Her favorite experience in college was a 3 month study abroad program in Florence, Italy, studying Art History, Drawing & Painting.


offers me a place to meditate on the beauty in the world & the grace I feel while living in it. "

## Lawrence County Art Show Entry Deadline: November 1, 2021 Open to ages 18+.

**Deadline for Entries**: November 1, 2021 (drop off Oct 27 – Nov 1) **Notification of Awards by November 8, 2021**.

Exhibition Dates: November 12, 2021 to February 28, 2022 Public reception: November 12, 2021, 5-7 pm (Awards at 6 pm) Pick up: February 28 to March 11, 2022 (May pick up earlier if needed)

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Lawrence County Art Competition is open to artists 18+. Only two-dimensional media will be considered. No jewelry, sculpture, pottery, video/film or other three-dimensional work will be accepted.

Works must be original and depict a person, place or event in Lawrence County. Please be specific as possible in naming the location and/or significance of the subject on your entry form.

Work cannot exceed 36" in any direction or 50lbs in weight. All work must be professionally prepared for display, meaning framed and wired to hang. If using a mat, neutral or white is preferred. Paper works should be protected by glass or plexi-glass. Special display instructions should be clearly noted on the entry form. The Lawrence County Art Competition Committee has final authority to define what constitutes an acceptable entry. Works may be declined if not adequately prepared for display or considered unsafe or inappropriate for public view.

**ENTRY:** Works may be delivered in person to the Register and Recorder's Office at the Lawrence County Courthouse, 430 Court Street, New Castle from October 27th to November 1st between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm.

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per work. No limit to number of entries.

**AWARDS:** Cash Awards: 1st Place: \$175.00, 2nd Place: \$125.00, 3rd Place: \$75.00

Purchase Awards: Up to a total of \$1500.00 collectively may be available to acquire artwork from the competition to build the County's Art Collection. These pieces will remain on permanent display at the Lawrence County Courthouse.

**NOTIFICATION:** Award winners will be notified by November 8, 2021. Awards will be announced at the Public Reception on November 12th.

**SALES**: Potential sales will be referred directly to the artist.

**PICK UP:** Work may be picked up from the Register and Recorder's Office at the Lawrence County Courthouse on week days from 9 am to 3 pm, February 28 to March 11, 2022.




