


OCTOBER 2022 CHALLENGE: AUTUMN COLOR PALETTE



As we are a public library, we cannot accept any pieces with full frontal nudity, profane words, or violent/disturbing imagery.


Pieces are evaluated at the Volunteer Exhibits Curator's discretion.
