One of my current project is the process of frottage (art) to create a rubbing of a manhole cover with oil pastels on canvas. This new and interesting idea has turned into something visually rewarding and historically interesting. It's not only inspiring for myself but also for anyone who chances to pass by as I create the rubbing. The final piece is a colorful, graphically interesting manhole cover rubbing on canvas. The art forever preserves a tiny piece of history that otherwise goes unnoticed."

FROTTAGE (art): A technique in the visual arts of obtaining textural effects or images by rubbing lead, chalk, charcoal, etc., over a paper or canvas laid on a textured or raised surface.



Call for artists! Sweetwater is currently seeking artists for our 2023 Holiday Market. Artists may either apply to vend their own table/booth OR consignment space.

Dates: Thursday, November 30th – Sunday, December 3rd Application Deadline: September 5th at midnight Artist Notification: September 22nd

Sweetwater Center for the Artists is seeking 2 groups of artists to vend their own 6' x 6' space in our Community Room.

GROUP 1 artists will vend Thursday, November 30th from 5-10 p.m., and Friday, December 1st from 1-9 p.m. (13 hours total). Thursday, November 30th will serve as the Holiday Market preview party with a VIP donor reception, and Friday, December 1st runs in conjunction with Sewickley's Light Up Night.

GROUP 2 artists will vend Saturday, December 2nd from 11 a.m. – 7 p.m. and Sunday, December 3rd from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. (13 hours total).

Both GROUP 1 and GROUP 2 will be responsible for their displays and table space within a 6' x 6' area. These vendors will be responsible for

their sales and transaction, Sweetwater will not take a percentage of sales. Upon acceptance, artists will be responsible for a \$125 booth fee made payable to Sweetwater Center for the Arts.

CONSIGNMENT ARTISTS will apply to have their work displayed for the course of the 4 days in Sweetwater's gallery/ consignment space. Consignment artists must drop off their work at Sweetwater NO LATER THAN MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13TH. Artists within the consignment space do not need to be present at the time of sales, for Sweetwater will handle all sales and transactions. Sweetwater will receive 30% of artist proceeds from sales.

Sweetwater's gallery will serve as the consignment artist area and is located on the mezzanine level of Sweetwater's Community Room with wood floors and natural lighting. Sweetwater's gallery is currently not wheelchair accessible.

Pittsburgh Watercolor Society is delighted to present a Weekend Watercolor Landscape Workshop with Christopher Leeper. A frequent award winner in several juried and invitational Plein Air events yearly, his work is seen in solo exhibitions throughout the country. Chris wrote and illustrated Realism in Watermedia (North Light), and has had work featured in The Artist Magazine, Plein Air Magazine, Watercolor Magic, and Ohio Magazine. A 2020 finalist in the Plein Air Magazine Salon, his work was featured in August/September 2021 issue. Chris also serves on the Board of Trustees of the Ohio Plein Air Society, is Past President of the Ohio Watercolor Society, and is a signature member of the National Oil and Acrylic Painters' Society. The first half hour of painting is "make it or break it" time. Learn the importance of value, color temperature, and intensity to spend more time painting and less time mixing.

There will be demonstrations with time for one-on-one instruction during the workshop. Participants may bring their own reference photos, and Chris will have reference photos available to paint. He can also provide the demo image to those who want to draw before the workshop. The emphasis is on value, but participants will also learn how a variety of colors can be obtained with a minimum number of paints.
