## Welcome Holly Pultz, Oil Painter Thursday, Sept 21st

Join us as we welcome Holly Pultz, as we kick off the first meeting of our 2018/19 season. Holly will demonstrate her 'lift off' technique using oil paint on gessoed watercolor paper.



After reviewing images of landscapes and

considering several preferred compositions, Holly begins by painting with mixtures of burn umber and ultramarine blue. After a quick random start, she organizes values and shapes. With rags dipped in Gamsol in one hand and brushes in the other, she rubs out (and paints back in) as the image unfolds.
