Bookmarks. Please remember to bring at least three bookmarks (Size 2-1/4 x 7") to the April meeting. Be sure to sign your bookmark so whomever receives it knows what artist to credit for their beautiful work.

The Prospectus for this year's show is posted online and included here for quick reference:

Prospectus

Our annual art exhibit is open to all active members whose membership dues are paid in full. Each member is limited to two pieces of artwork unless otherwise stated. All mediums are accepted.

- Entry fee is \$5.00 per piece and must be paid at drop off. To expedite the check in process, the check – in process by having correct change or your completed check at drop off.
- All artwork must be delivered ready to hang and include any accessories, electronics and hanging wires. **Quality framing or mounting is required.**
- All submissions must have been completed within the past two years, not exhibited in a prior WHAL Art Show and not completed in a workshop or under instruction.
- All artwork will be displayed for the duration of the show (no exceptions).
- Original artwork only. No giclees.
- Using (2) 3 x 5" index cards, include the following information:
Name of artwork
Medium used:
Dimensions (unframed height x width)
Price (or NFS)
Artist's name

Attach one index card to the front of the artwork with tape; another to the back.

Please have all identification cards and payment (cash or check) completed before drop off to expedite the check-in process.

Note: Artwork that does not meet the above criteria will be disqualified.

A 20% commission to WHAL is suggested for each piece of artwork sold.
